I am directed to refer to Medical Council of India's letter dated 04.01.2017 on the subject mentioned above and to convey approval of the Central Government to the recommendation of Medical Council of India for recognition of M.Ch (Urology) qualification against increased intake permitted from 02 to 03 seats granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students trained at Topiwala National Medical College, Mumbai.

2. The recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate course.
